## v26.1.0.0

MAJOR

January 30, 2026 · Major

Major release delivering the .NET Core 10 platform upgrade, a WiX 6 installer migration, a new Vehicle Pursuit supplement, and Azure SQL Managed Instance support.

- NEW FEATURE** .NET Core 10 upgrade — core ARMS services (Identity Service, NCIC Query, Notification Manager, Web Arms) modernized onto the latest .NET platform.
- NEW FEATURE** Installer platform migrated from WiX 3 to WiX 6 for continued installer supportability.
- NEW FEATURE** Case Log Supplement — new "Vehicle Pursuit" report type added.
- ENHANCEMENT** Merge Names candidate grid and CSV export — DL Number, DL State, and SSN columns added.
- ENHANCEMENT** Desktop Installer — Azure SQL Managed Instance support added.
- ENHANCEMENT** AL NIBRS Import Wizard now links the Society victim to all applicable offenses in a case, instead of only one.
- IMPROVEMENT** 6 updates refining agency workflows — Domestic Violence supplement dropdowns now populate involved parties correctly, the default flat-file export uses the correct NIBRS schema, Segment 9 (URTV) NIBRS handling was refined, MO NIBRS 2.2 extract behavior was improved, System Defaults Chief dropdown behavior was refined, and Desktop installation on older databases runs more smoothly.

Major release adding arrestee-location fields directly to the AL NIBRS review, surfacing state-level submission messages earlier in validation, and closing out a round of SCIBRS/Texas crime-code testing feedback.

- NEW FEATURE** Portal Sync Client — CaseLogIncident count added to the Sync API.
- ENHANCEMENT** AL NIBRS review — arrestee location fields (address, ZIP, county) can now be completed directly in the review, without editing the case log first.
- ENHANCEMENT** AL NIBRS validation now surfaces state-level submission messages in ARMS before extraction, instead of only after state submission.
- ENHANCEMENT** SCIBRS and Texas NIBRS crime-code testing feedback incorporated, including the Texas 90Z code and South Carolina crime codes 756/978.
- SUPPORT** WebARMS security hardening — findings from the January 2026 Qualys vulnerability scan addressed.
- IMPROVEMENT** 14 updates refining agency workflows — Mobile CAD vehicle-stop and time-zone behavior improved, WebCAD officer login now completes reliably under all conditions, Master Name Associations and Code List saving behavior refined, Case Management 09c crime-code handling corrected, and Night Mode readability improved in search dropdowns.
