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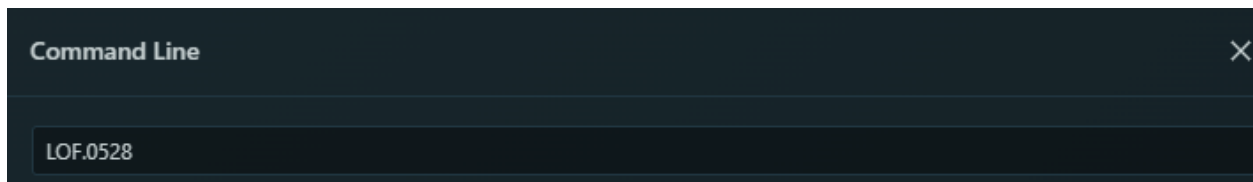
Open command line shortcut is

When using the command line, never use the spacebar unless you are entering a note or using the keyboard shortcut Ctrl + Spacebar to display the available commands.

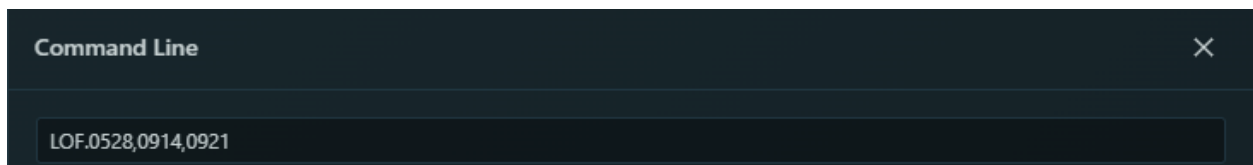
