






Navigating to the Setup Menu

Updating a Code with “Conflict Resolving”


If you select a code to update, that code may need some **Conflict Resolving**.

These are codes in your **ARMS** that could be matched to one in the standardized list but are altered.

This screen will show you the **Conflict Description** which will show you the **Description** of the code you currently have and then point to the appropriate value.

You can choose to keep the old code and mark it as inactive, check to **Keep Duplicate** box. This will also still import the appropriate value.


Leaving the **Keep Duplicate** box unchecked will update the old code with the appropriate value.



Navigating to Crime Code


From the **Setup Menu**, go to the **Crime and Incident** module.

For **NIBRS**, you'll want to edit the crime code to have the correct **UCR Offense** code and have the correct **Crime Against** checkbox checked.









Then select the **Name Type** and map it to the **NIBRS Resident Status** that matches it closest.

If the **Name Type** doesn't match a **NIBRS Resident Status**, you'll be able to manually enter it for each **NIBRS Review**.
